Infographics use pictures and other visuals to represent data, knowledge and other information clearly and quickly.



- **REGRETS:** Do you wish you had done some other things to be better prepared?
- **FUTURE**: Based on information from the previous lesson (#3: Looking Ahead), find or create a slogan/ motto / saying that represents your future and / or your "dreams."
 - Examples: "Just keep swimming!" –Finding Nemo
 "If you keep on believing, the dreams that you wish will come true." Cinderella
